This track is designed for non-clinicians or those not eligible to become Certified Imago Therapists® and for those who are not seeking certification. (i.e. spouses, of a therapist, ministers, attorneys, teacher, physicians, or a therapist who is only wanting to learn the skills of Imago therapy but is not planning on becoming a Certified Imago Therapist®).

Those taking this Educational Track will not be certified at the end of the training. They will be auditing the course for educational purposes. They cannot use the terms “Certified Imago Therapist®”, “Imago Therapist”, or “Trained in Imago Therapy” in any advertising materials.

Admission Requirements:

- 1) Participants must participate in a twenty hour ““Getting the Love You Want”” couples workshop led by a Certified Workshop Presenter®.
- 2) Two letters of recommendation from persons who believe that the participant can effectively work in and benefit from a university level class. Writers should list their qualifications as well as the basis on which they make this judgment.

Description of the Course

The course program will be the same as the Basic Clinical Training Program for the clinical track except there will be no in-between session assignments required. During the practice sessions, the Educational Track participants can get experience and coaching in non-regressive processes. Also, upon request, they may role-play a short situation that comes from their work context and receive feedback from the class and instructor. If they choose to do an in-between videoed assignment, they may present 15 minutes of it in class and get feedback.

Tuition

\$2,000
