Educational  
Track for  
Certification**

Open to people such as coaches, educators, physicians, deemed to be working at an acceptable level by their Imago clinical Instructor, who wish to use Imago concepts in a non-therapy setting.

**Admission Requirements:**

1. Complete the Educational Track of the Imago Basic Clinical Training including assisting at a workshop and providing the two follow-up papers.
2. For their first between session assignments they would be required to submit a passing tape of facilitating an Imago dialogue at a level of content appropriate to their skills and training.
3. In lieu of the 2<sup>nd</sup> clinical tape they would be required to do a project to be designed with the support of their clinical instructor, relevant to their field of interest and the use to which they imagine putting their Imago skills.
4. Complete additional readings or coursework on adult learning.
5. Engage in on-going consultation of their activities under the rubric of Imago for a 2 year period following certification (e.g. discuss ideas, content and format for presentations, etc. past an approved Imago practitioner, submitting evaluations or possibly tapes of their presentations).
6. Attend a training module in handling situations where issues or materials arise that fall outside of their expertise, and in procedures for referring them to a certified Imago Relationship Therapist.\*
7. Attend an Imago presentation skills module or receive individual coaching in Imago presentation styles from an Imago workshop presenter or faculty member.\*\*

**Requirements to Maintain Certification**

1. Attend an Imago Conference or agreed upon substitute every two years.
2. Submit evaluations from clients/students to a designated committee every two years and achieve an acceptable standard of excellence.

**Limitations and Responsibilities**

1. Limit use and application of Imago concepts and processes to the areas of expertise that fall within their previously acquired training and competence.
2. Refrain from using or demonstrating regressive or deep affective Imago processing.
3. Have established connections with Imago therapists to whom they refer.

**Certification Permissions:**

**Graduates may:**

1. Identify and market themselves as Certified Imago Educators
2. Be listed on the international web site as Certified Imago Educators
3. Have membership status within IRI as Certified Imago Educators

**Fees (North America)**

1. Those on the Educational Track for certification would pay the full fee equivalent to the Clinical Certification Track. (\$2,500)

**Fees (Outside the USA)**

1. Those on the Educational Track for certification would pay the full fee equivalent to the Clinical Certification Track. The fee, including the deposit, is paid directly to the Clinical Instructor.

A non-refundable deposit of 20% (check or credit card made out to IRI) and the registration form are to be sent to: IRI Training Department, 250 Blackwater Pl, Longwood Florida 32750. Make sure you send a copy of the Registration Form and of the payment to the Clinical Instructor so that they have you on their roster of Trainees. The balance is due directly to the Clinical Instructor to be paid in full three weeks before the start of the training.
